Figure 1: Interaction Guidelines

Interaction Guidelines with Dogs	
Pet: Long soft stroke as if putting the baby to sleep	
Dog does	We do
The dog looks in our direction or approaches us	Present hands at the dog's eye level
When the dog is within arm's reach and all four paws are on the ground	Pet with one hand
Any paws come off the ground or the dog leaves	Pause petting (keep hands still)
All four paws return to the ground or the dog returns within arm's reach	Pet with one hand
At any point if the dog sits or lies down	Pet with two hands, get closer, and continue sharing affection

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Figure 2: Affection Loop

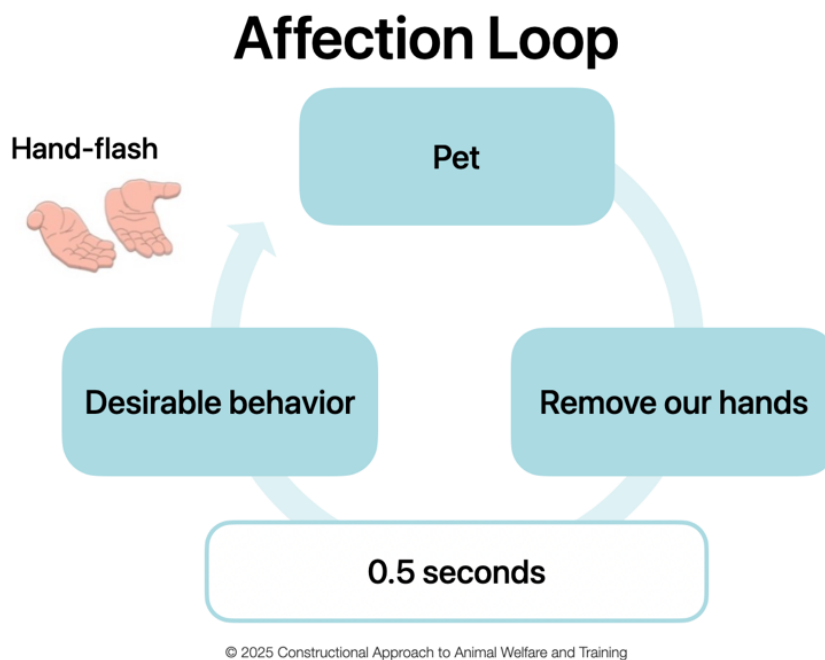


Figure 3: Step-graph of the initial affection loop steps for Chuu

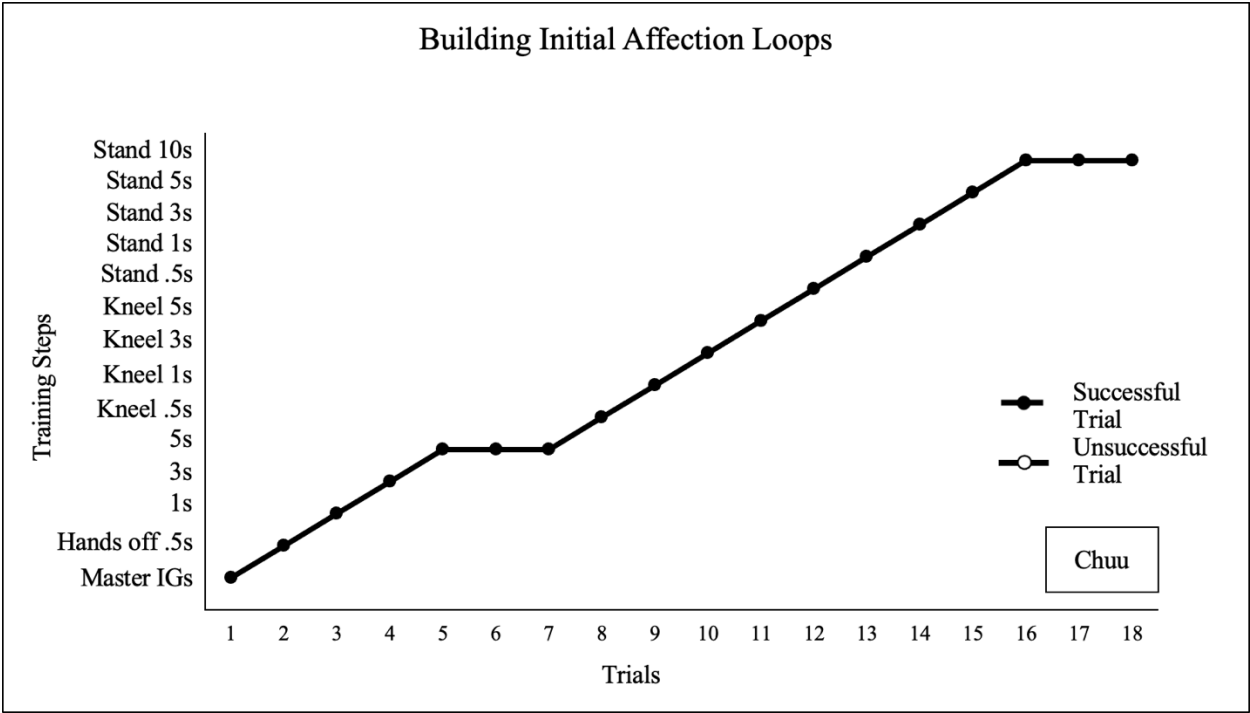


Figure 4: Step-graph of the affection loop steps to shape movement towards the doorway for Chuu

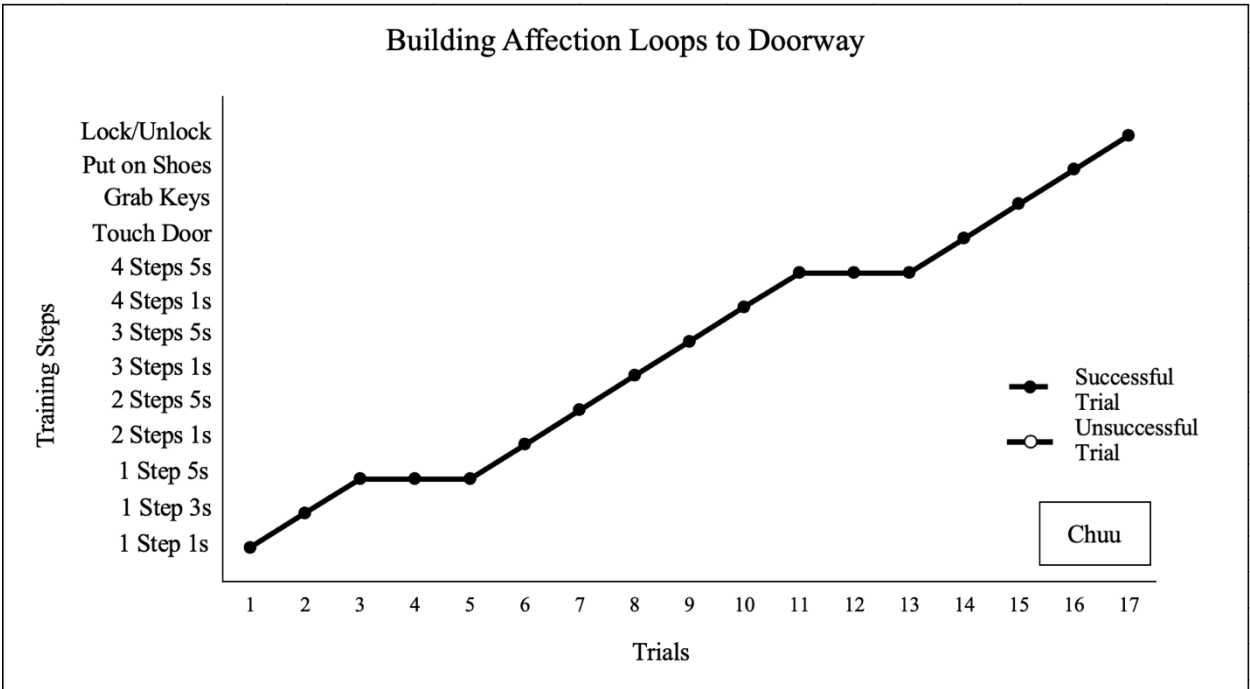


Figure 5: Step-graph of the affection loop steps to exit and enter the house for Chuu

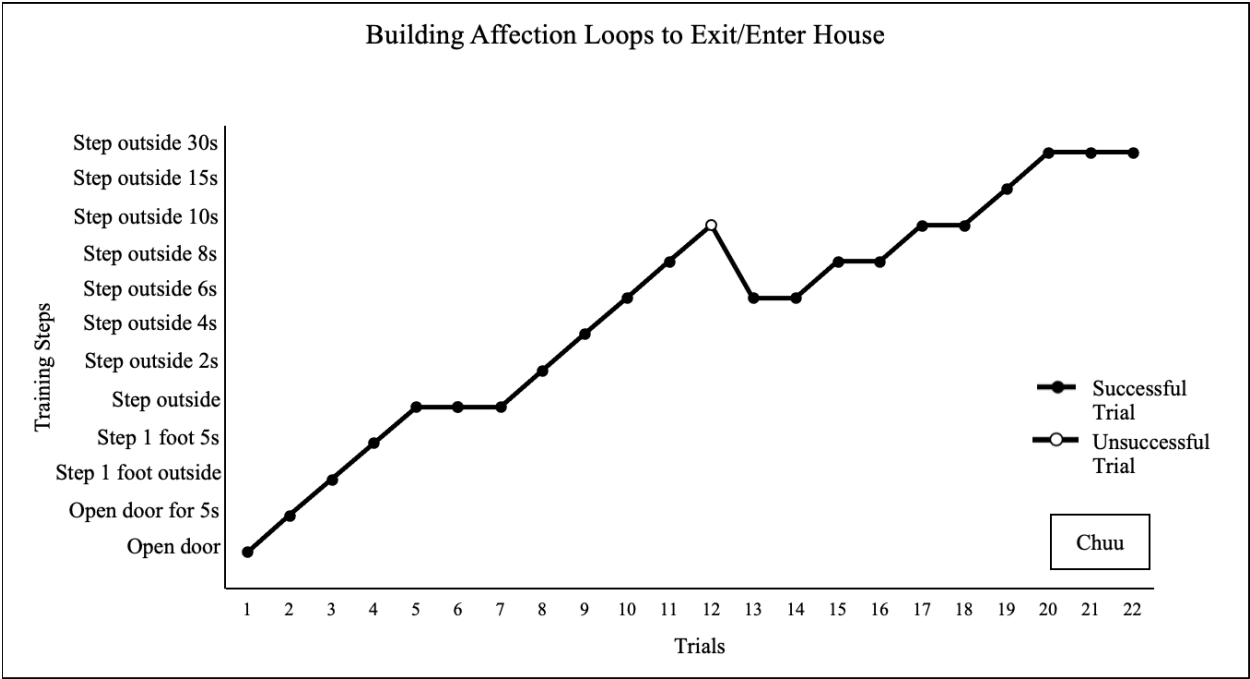


Figure 6: Step-graph of the affection loop steps to randomize the duration outside for Chuu

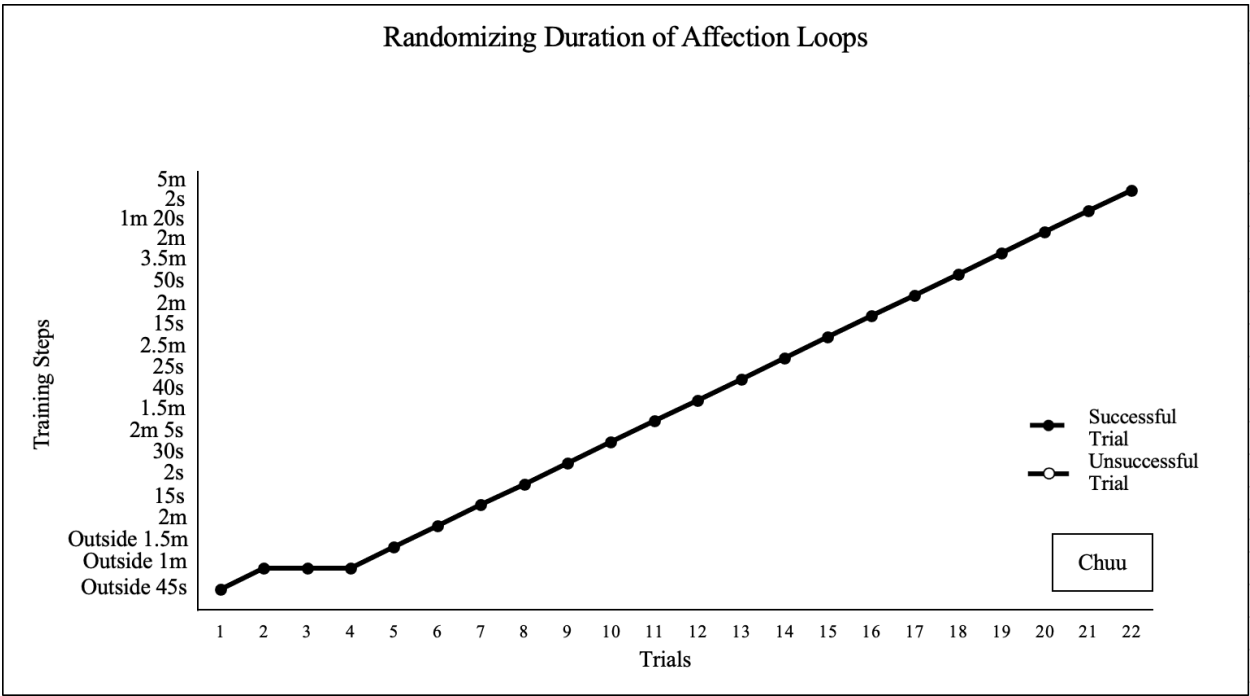


Figure 7: Step-graph of real-world departures after separation related behavior training for Chuu

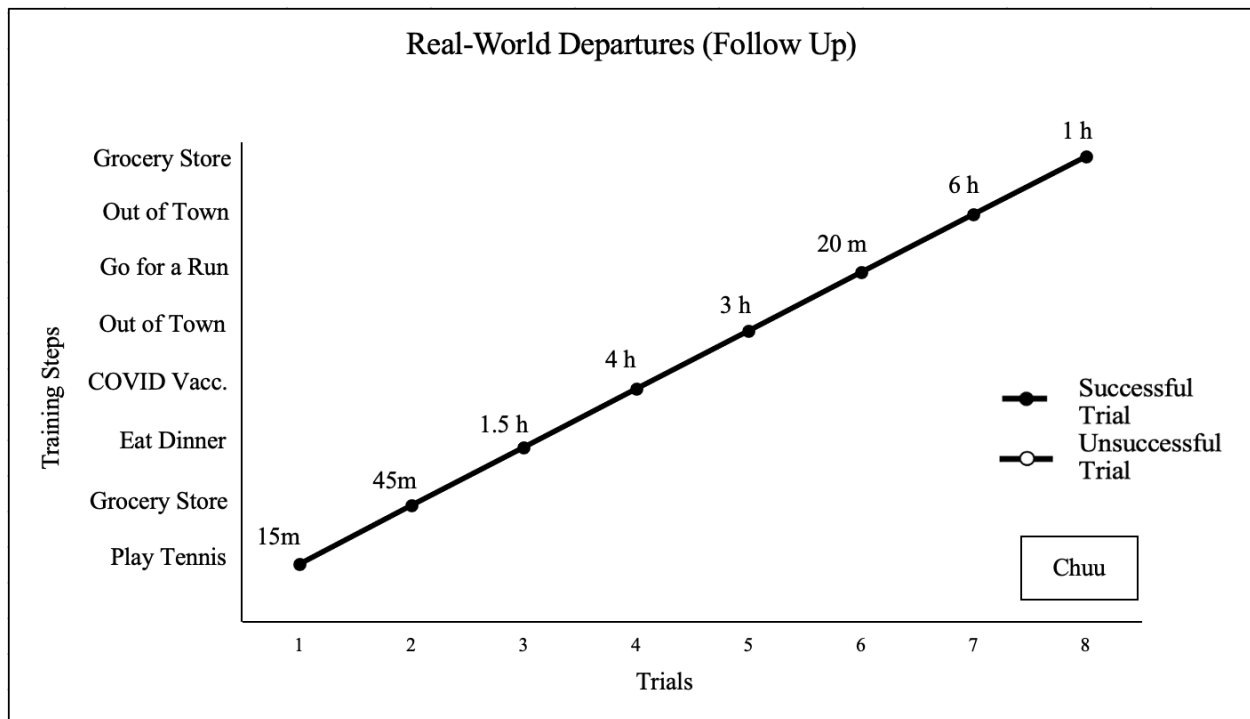


Figure 8: Step-graph of the initial affection loop steps for Remy

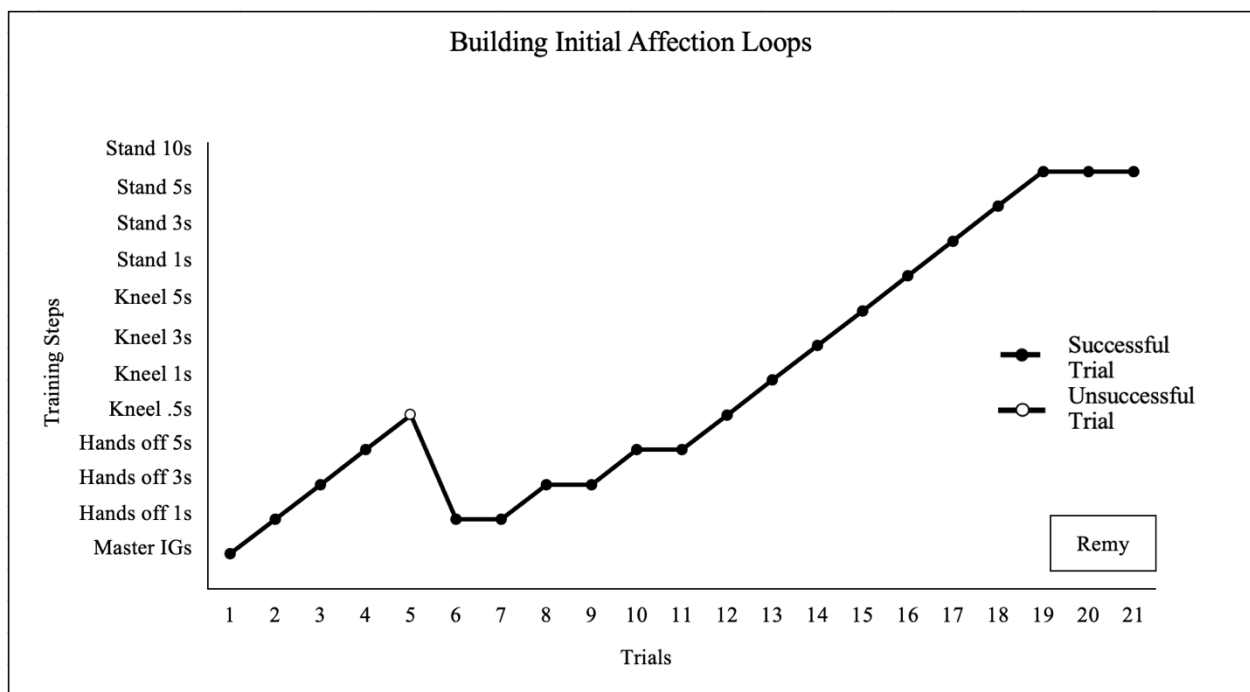


Figure 9: Step-graph of the affection loop steps to shape movement towards the doorway for Remy

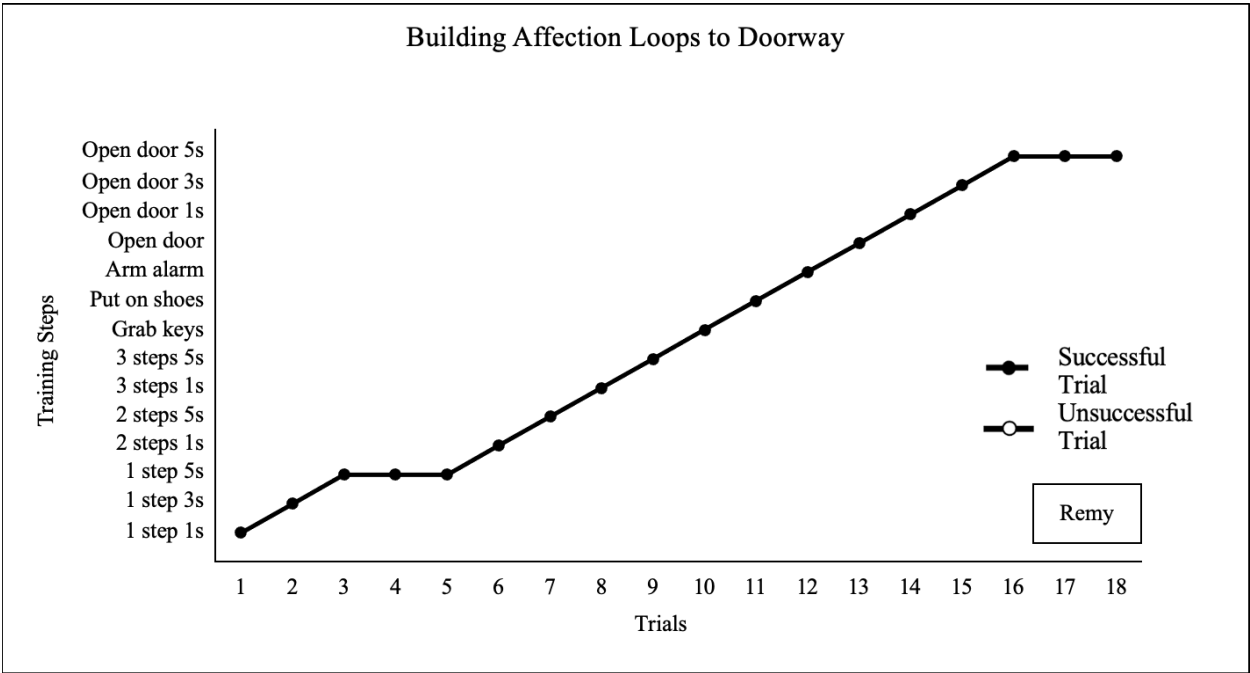


Figure 10: Step-graph of the affection loop steps to exit and enter the house for Remy

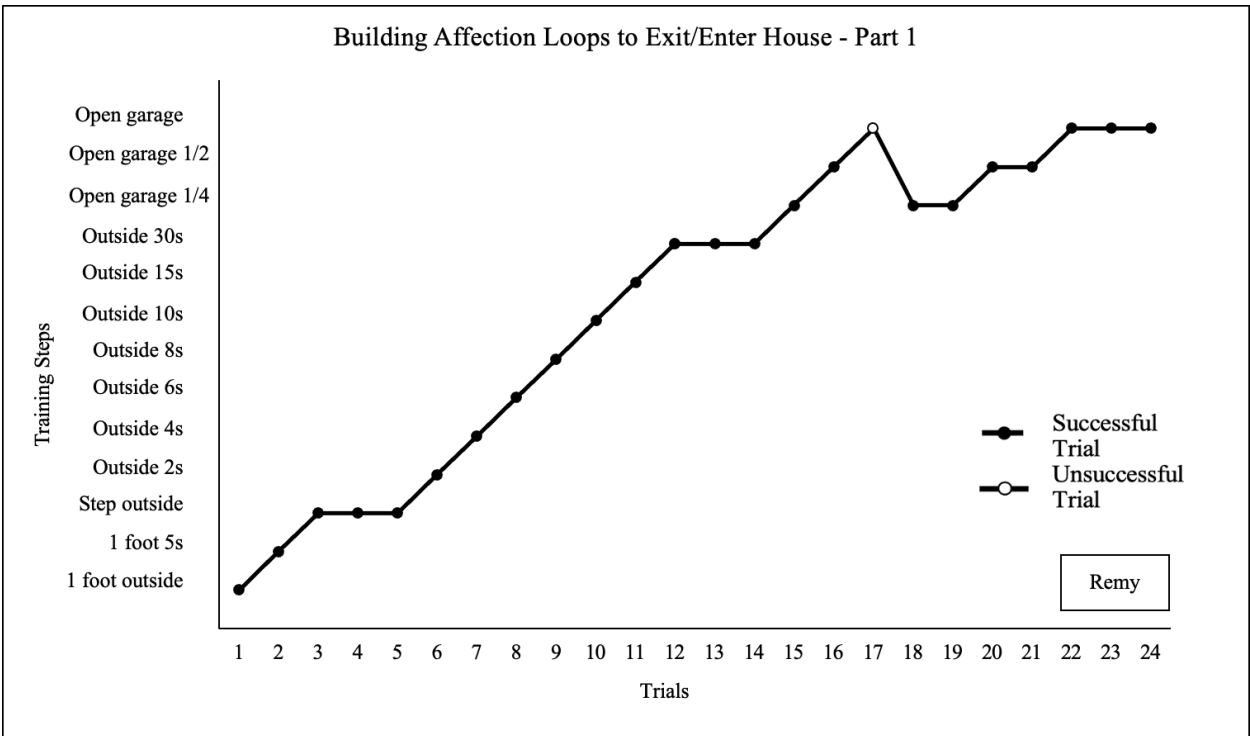


Figure 11: Step-graph of the affection loop steps to exit and enter the house for Remy

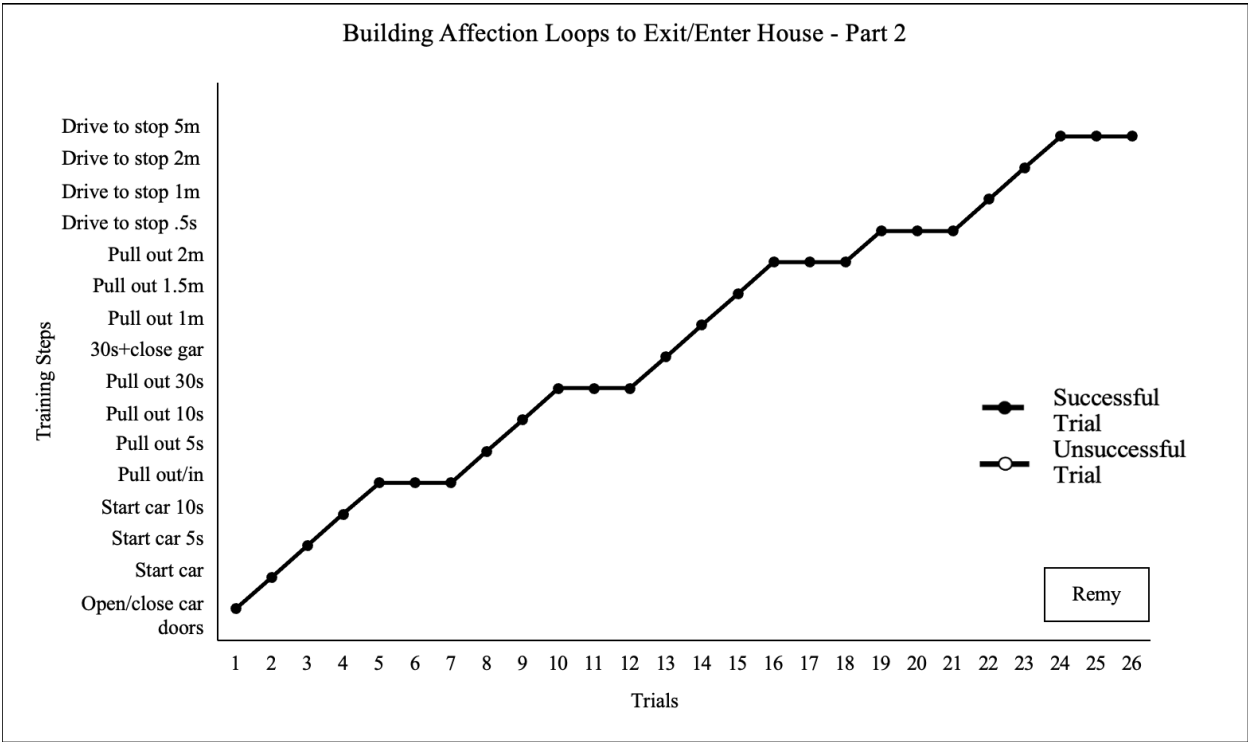


Figure 12: Step-graph of the affection loop steps to randomize the duration outside for Remy

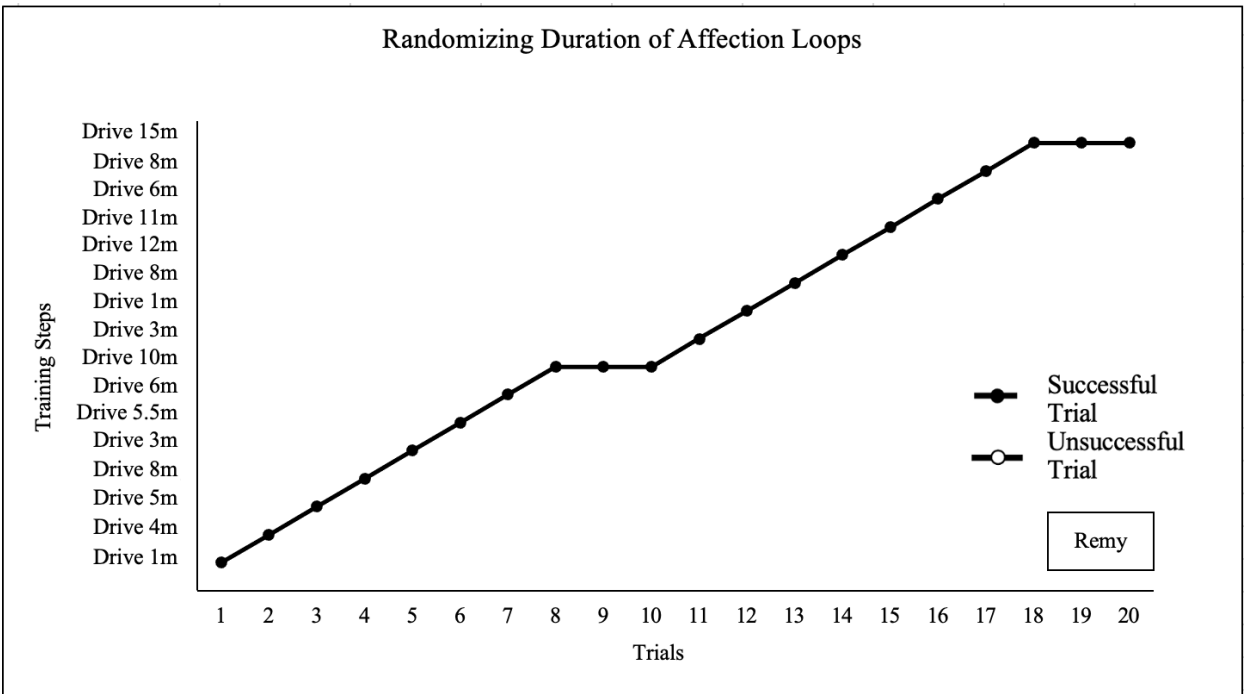


Figure 13: Step-graph of real-world departures after separation related behavior training for Remy
